

727 MODIFIED MEMBRANE ADHESIVE

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Product Use: Malarkey Roofing Products™ (Malarkey) 727 Modified Membrane Adhesive is a high strength, heavy-duty asphaltic adhesive for cementing together layers of SBS-modified roofing in the construction of cold process built-up roofs. The initial bond is strong and will hold roofing firmly in place soon after it is applied. The final cure comes slower and allows the roofing to flatten into place. May also be used for adhering granules or gravel to BUR surfaces. Complies with ASTM D 3019 Type III.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Malarkey 727 Modified Membrane Adhesive is ready to use after mixing. Do not thin. Apply with a roof brush, squeegee, roller or high pressure spray equipment at the rate of approximately two gallons per 100 square feet. Press the roofing into the wet adhesive. Best results are obtained by nailing the first layer to the sheathing and bonding the successive layers with the adhesive. Do not adhere roofing membranes directly to the sheathing. Allow adequate cure time before top coating. Ambient conditions are a factor. Weather conditions should be dry and clear, with a temperature maintaining at least 40° F (4° C) and rising.
